**subject:** NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION  
Reconstruction of the Long Ridge Road  
Railroad/Highway At-Grade Crossing  
Redding, Connecticut

**date:** June 19, 2017

**TYPE OF PROJECT:** The upgrading of the Long Ridge Road railroad/highway at-grade crossing on the Danbury Branch of the Metro-North Commuter Railroad. The upgrading includes the replacement of the existing crossing surface. Work will be performed by the Metro-North Commuter Railroad.

**WHERE:** Town of Redding, Long Ridge Road

**WHEN:** Complete road closure of Long Ridge Road at the railroad/highway at-grade crossing will begin at 10:00 a.m. Friday, July 7, 2017 and is expected to remain closed until 4 p.m. Wednesday, July 12, 2017.

**TERMINI:** Work will be confined to the area of the railroad/highway at-grade crossing.

**SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES:** It is expected that there will be a complete closure at the railroad/highway at-grade crossing for a six (6) day period. All associated emergency personnel for the Town of Redding have been notified. The detour will be implemented via fixed message signs installed by Metro-North Commuter Railroad.

On Saturday (July 8<sup>th</sup>) and Sunday (July 9<sup>th</sup>) there will be no train service between Danbury and Norwalk. Train service is expected to resume on schedule on Monday (July 10<sup>th</sup>).

There will be an increase in noise levels in the vicinity of the railroad crossing due to the construction. There also will be construction activities occurring at night starting Friday (July 7<sup>th</sup>) until Monday morning (July 10<sup>th</sup>).
