LEGAL NOTICE

TWO TAX BENEFITS FOR THE ELDERLY

1. STATE BENEFIT

Persons 65 years of age or over who have become property owners in the Town of Redding by October 1, 2018, and who meet the following qualifications, must file the prescribed form between February 1, 2019 thru May 15, 2019. Forms are available at the Assessor's office.

Qualifications: Must be 65 years of age or over, spouse domiciled with resident.

Occupy real property as home.

Have an adjusted gross income, determined by the last completed federal income tax return, Not to exceed \$43,900 married or \$36,000 single.

Social Security income is also included.

Must be a resident of the State for six months and a day.

A penalty is provided for anyone making a false affidavit or neglecting to notify the Assessor of exceeded income.

2. TOWN BENEFIT

All Residents 65 years or older who have lived in Redding 3 years or more and have Redding as Their Domicile Residence may apply to the:

Redding Assessor's office from February 1, 2019 through May 15, 2019 for a reduction on their property tax. Please bring PHOTO ID.

Residents who is already on The Town Benefit need **NOT** reapply.
