

**INVITATION TO BID**  
**TOWN OF REDDING**  
**REPLACEMENT OF STEPNEY ROAD BRIDGE**  
**OVER THE ASPETUCK RIVER**

The Town of Redding is requesting sealed bids from contractors for a bridge replacement project which is proposed for the Stepney Road Bridge over the Aspetuck River. The project calls for the superstructure removal of the existing Stepney Road Bridge over the Aspetuck River, modification of the existing abutments, and removal and replacement of steel-backed timber rail. Installation of a new timber superstructure will be by York Bridge Concepts, coordinated by the contractor. The bid entails providing unit cost figures for all of the items listed in the Schedule of Bid Items which is included in the Form of Bid in the Project Manual. Sealed bids will be received at the Finance Department in Town Hall, 100 Hill Road, Redding, CT, until 2 PM on March 28, 2016 and will be publicly opened and read at that time.

There is a \$70.00 fee for hard copy plans and specifications; bidders are responsible for shipping costs, or pick up at the Advance Reprographics office. Plans and specifications may also be ordered by calling the Advanced Reprographics number listed above. Bidders are responsible for obtaining all and the latest addendums from the Advanced Reprographic website.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check of the bidder, or a bid bond for at least five percent (5%) of the amount of the total base bid.

The contract will be awarded based on the total base bid only.

The Town of Redding reserves the right to accept and/or reject any or all bids; and to waive any informalities in bidding if deemed in the best interests of the Town of Redding. Bids will not be accepted from anyone owing taxes to, or currently involved in a legal dispute with the Town of Redding.
