(This includes \$14,990,463 for the Town Operating Budget; \$22,067,447 for the Redding Board of Education Budget and \$13,903,087 for Redding's share of the Region No. 9 Budget). **PASSED**

Shall the Regional School District No. 9, composed of the Towns of Easton and Redding, appropriate and authorize the expenditure of \$24,133,114 as the operating budget of the district for the period of July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020? (Easton's share is \$10,230,027 and Redding's share is \$13,903,087).
