

BOARD OF ASSESSMENT APPEALS NOTICE RE MOTOR VEHICLE HEARINGS

The Board of Assessment Appeals for motor vehicle hearings will meet in the Town Hall Hearing Room on Thursday, September 17, 2020 from 4:30 PM to 6:30 PM. Applications for appeal are made on a walk-in basis, first come, first served. COVID precautions will be taken, including sanitizing, social distancing and masks worn by all. Only one applicant will be heard at a time. This session is for motor vehicle appeals **only**. Walk-in applicants should call 203-938-3616 upon arrival to be escorted into the Town Hall Hearing Room.

An alternate option is for teleconferencing (zoom). If teleconference is preferred, the Application for Appeal form and all supporting documents must be complete and received by the Board of Assessment Appeals office by 3:30 PM on Tuesday, September 15, 2020.

Applications received for virtual teleconference attendance will be added to the agenda and applicants will be contacted with instructions on how to attend the meeting (with Meeting ID, password, dial-in phone number, etc.) prior to the hearing. The Applicant or an authorized Agent for the Applicant must attend the teleconference on September 17, 2020 to present their appeal to the Board.
