

**NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS,
GEORGETOWN AND REDDING**

**THE FIRST INSTALLMENT OF REAL ESTATE, PERSONAL
PROPERTY AND MOTOR VEHICLE TAXES ON THE GRAND LIST OF
OCTOBER 1, 2020, IS DUE AND PAYABLE JULY 1, 2021.
PAYMENTS MUST BE POSTMARKED OR PAID ONLINE, NO LATER
THAN AUGUST 2, 2021, TO AVOID PENALTY.
TAXES ARE DELINQUENT AUGUST 3, 2021.
FAILURE TO RECEIVE A TAX BILL DOES NOT EXEMPT YOU
FROM PAYMENT OF TAX OR PENALTY.**

Payments postmarked, Paid in Person or Online, on or after August 3, 2021, are delinquent and will carry an interest penalty. Interest is charged at the rate of eighteen (18%) percent annually or one and one-half percent per month, from the July 1, 2021, due date.

Motor Vehicle Taxes are due in full July 1, 2021. Failure to make payment in accordance with the above will result in suspension of registration privileges in addition to the interest charges. Delinquent Motor Vehicle Taxes must be paid in cash, certified check, money order or online by credit card, to obtain a registration clearance.

**DO NOT INCLUDE FIRE DISTRICT TAX PAYMENTS WITH YOUR TOWN
PAYMENT. Checks will be returned and payment will be invalid until a
corrected check is received.**
