ARPA Working Group Summary of Work as of June 2nd, 2022

- We have received 20 project proposals to date. 8 are from NGO's, 7 from the Town of Redding or Redding BoE, 2 from Fire Depts, 2 from private businesses and 1 from ER9. The count does not include the MTL proposal we expect to receive in the next week or several proposals under consideration by the BoE. The total dollar amount of the 20 projects, plus an estimate for the MTL, is just over \$2.4 million.
- The Working Group has recommended 7 projects to the BoS for a value of approximately \$500,000 and the Town has approved 6 to date. Two can be described as designed to increase the Town's resources to provide assistance directly to families impacted by Covid. Two are public safety projects. Three provide funds for projects-one at each school including the High School- to enhance facilities for outdoor activity or update HVAC equipment.
- We have reviewed 6 additional projects that total \$877,000. They are heavily oriented towards expanding the Town's open space recreational facilities.
- For June we currently plan to review 5 projects that could total roughly \$750,000.
