An annual permit is required is the use the facility

Kitchen & Household Garbage: **\$ 0.25 per pound**

Organics/Food Scraps: **\$ 0.10 per pound**

Bulky Waste: **\$ 0.15 per pound**

Couches, Chairs, Tables, Sinks, Toilets, Bathtubs, Empty Paint Cans,
Garden hoses etc.

Demolition: **\$ 0.15 per pound**

Lumber, Plywood, Sheetrock, Asphalt Shingles, Broken Cement etc....

Metal: **\$ 0.15 per pound**

Washer, Dryer, Water Tank, Water Heater, Lawn Mowers/No Gas or Oil
Lawn Tractor/No Gas or Oil

Grills, Exercise Bikes, Furnace/Boiler, Bathtub, Sinks....

Car Batteries, Wet Cell Batteries **\$2 - \$10 each**

Propane tanks (20 lbs.) **\$5.00 each**

Tires:

Passenger \$3.00 Truck \$6.00 Larger \$15.00

Rims Add +1.00 ... +2.00 +3.00

Appliances Containing FREON:

Refrigerators Freezers Air Conditioners Central Air Units Dehumidifiers

\$20.00 each to cover Freon removal

Commercial Coolers and Freezers \$30.00 to 50.00

Brush:

Residents Free when self hauled

Incidental use only no land clearing no stumps

Commercial Brush & Wood Chips \$10 per Cubic Yard

Leaves and Weeds are No Longer Accepted.

The Recycling Center Accepts
at NO CHARGE to Residents
An annual permit is required to use the facility:

- ✓ Single Stream Recyclables – glass must be separated out
- ✓ Latex and Oil base Paints. Stains
- ✓ Electronics- TV's, VCR's, DVD players, Stereos, etc....
- ✓ Textile Recycling Program
- ✓ Waste motor oil and drained filters
- ✓ Auto Antifreeze
- ✓ Rechargeable Batteries, Ni-Cd, Ni-MH, Li-ion, Ni-Zn, Small Sealed Lead
- ✓ Brush - **Incidental use only no land clearing no stumps**
- ✓ Eye Glasses-Yellow Lions Club Drop Off
- ✓ Packing Peanuts (*no chunk Styrofoam, no bubble wrap*)
- ✓ Fluorescent Tubes & Compact fluorescent bulbs
- ✓ Cooking Oil- Vegetable, Canola, Peanut & Olive Oil **NO FATS**
- ✓ Clean Mattresses & Foundations
- ✓ Plastic Wrap including grocery bags, dry cleaning bags, air pillows
- ✓ Shredded Paper
