Redding COVID Booster Shots and Seasonal Flu Shots

Redding will be holding two walk-in **COVID-19 booster shot clinics** at the Redding Community Center. The dates are Friday, September 30th from 1:00-4:00 p.m., and Saturday, October 1st from 1:00-4:00 p.m.

The updated COVID-19 booster vaccines provide an immune response that is protective against the omicron variant BA.4 and BA.5. Both Moderna and Pfizer boosters will be available. The Moderna booster is approved for individuals 18 years of age and older, and the Pfizer booster is approved for individuals 12 years of age and older. Only those who have completed the primary shot series and with the most recent shot received at least 2 months ago are eligible for this updated booster.

Vaccine will also be available for those receiving the COVID-19 vaccination for the first time. The Pfizer vaccine is available for those age 6 months and up. At this time, the new booster for the pediatric age group has not been approved, however CDC's approval recommendation is expected soon.

Be sure to bring your vaccination card(s).

A **seasonal flu clinic** will be held on Monday, October 3rd from 1:00-3:00 p.m. at the Redding Community Center. Medicare, Anthem Blue Cross/Blue Shield, Connecticare, Harvard Pilgram, and Aetna insurance will be accepted. For private pay it is \$75 for Adjuvanted Quadrivalent (65 & older) and \$55 for regular Quadrivalent.

For all clinics be sure to bring your insurance card and ID.

Masks are required.
