1. Zach Smith called the meeting to order at 4:02 pm.
2. Approval of the minutes tabled until December 2022 meeting.
3. Old Business
 - The Parade Path Tree Removal: Alice Smith suggested the town keep an eye on the Path, especially after a very dry summer and the drought we experienced.
 - Covid-19 Update by Doug Hartline: D. Hartline reported that there will be an updated COVID vaccine that will soon be made available. Whether or not the town decides to hold a vaccination clinic is not yet determined. In the meantime, people can go to pharmacies to receive them. No Monkey Pox has been reported in our town.
