

Town of Redding 2023-2024 Municipal Solid Waste Permit

Rules and Regulations

As authorized by the Municipal Solid Waste Ordinance approved by the Town of Redding and pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes regulating the disposal of solid waste generated within the Town of Redding, the following will be adhered to by all users of the Redding Transfer & Recycling Center.

- * All mandatory recyclables as designated by the State of Connecticut will be separated from other solid waste.
- * All MSW will be in tied bags.
- * No materials resulting from the construction or demolition of a building larger than 120 sq ft or an addition larger than 600 sq. ft. will be accepted.
- * No individual shall bring materials of any nature except from within the limits of the Town of Redding.
- * No Septic waste, liquid or semi solid industrial waste, toxic or hazardous waste of any kind.
- * No "Hot Loads" i.e. smoldering ashes from wood stove.
- * No Scavenging allowed without permission
- * No loitering

All users of the Transfer & Recycling Center shall pay the required fee and obtain a nontransferable permit for **each vehicle** used at the facility.

Permit sticker will be affixed to the lower passenger side of the windshield.

Permit will be revoked for violations of rules or failure to follow employee's directions.

Cash or Check Only. Permits can only be purchased at the Transfer Station.
