[COVIDtests.gov](https://www.covidtests.gov) site relaunched

Yesterday, the Administration for Strategic Preparedness and Response (ASPR) announced the relaunch of the [COVIDtests.gov](https://www.covidtests.gov) website. Beginning September 25, every household can again place an order to receive four more free COVID-19 rapid tests delivered directly to their home. Before you throw out 'expired' tests: [Check to see if your COVID-19 tests' expiration dates have been extended](#).

In addition to the federal government inviting U.S. households to order four free COVID-19 tests, there are numerous other options to get tested for free, such as [free community-based testing sites](#), including pharmacies, across the country. ASPR is also distributing free at-home tests to schools, nursing homes, community health centers, rural health clinics, food banks, and other community locations to ensure communities have widespread access to tests.
