**NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS,  
GEORGETOWN AND REDDING**

**THE SECOND INSTALLMENT OF REAL ESTATE and PERSONAL PROPERTY AND  
1<sup>st</sup> Installment SUPPLEMENTAL MOTOR VEHICLE TAXES ON THE GRAND LIST  
Of OCTOBER 1, 2022, IS DUE AND PAYABLE JANUARY 1, 2024.  
TAXES DUE JANUARY 1, 2024, MUST BE POSTMARKED OR  
PAID ONLINE, NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 1, 2024, TO  
AVOID PENALTY. TAXES ARE DELINQUENT FEBRUARY 2**

**Payments postmarked, Paid in Person or Paid online, on or after February 2, 2024, are delinquent and will carry an interest penalty. Interest is charged at the rate of Eighteen (18%) percent annually or one and one-half (1.5%) percent per month, from the January 1, 2024, due date.**

Supplemental Motor Vehicle Taxes are due in full January 1, 2024. Failure to make payment in accordance with the above will result in suspension of registration privileges in addition to the interest charges. **Delinquent Motor Vehicle Taxes must be paid in cash, certified check, money order or online by credit card, to obtain a registration clearance.**

**FAILURE TO RECEIVE A TAX BILL DOES NOT EXEMPT YOU  
FROM PAYMENT OF TAX OR PENALTY.**

**Oldest outstanding taxes must be paid prior to paying current taxes.**

**Taxes can be paid or viewed at [www.townofreddingct.org](http://www.townofreddingct.org). Credit card Payments are not accepted in person at the Tax Office. You may call (866) 923-8245 to make a credit/debit card payment.**
