Key Takeaways of Provisional Plan

- Adoption of the BEARS play structure. Seeking an additional structure for imaginative play. Seeking further specifications of site preparation.
- Adoption of Game Time shade structure as well as waterway triple. Seeking further specifications of site preparation.
- Reduction of shade element to a smaller size, 15 x 30 is recommended
- Recommendation to review pathway requirements to the play structure
- Adoption of additional improvements Including
 - Inflatable Paddle Boards
 - Funiyak Replacement due to age and disrepair
 - Additional picnic table
 - 3 additional benches - 1 on walk into the Pond; 2 at play structures
 - Replacement basketball headboards
 - New recreation: ping pong, corn hole, toy chest
 - Installation Little Free Library Box
