April 2024 Presidential Preference Primaries Registration Session and Tabulator Testing:

Friday, March 15, 2024 - Voter Registration Session

The Office of the Registrar of Voters will be holding the last voter registration session on **Friday, March 15th, 2024 from noon until 2:00 pm.** for the purpose of registration and/or enrollment of electors entitled to vote in the Presidential Preference Primaries. We will be holding this registration session in person at Town Hall in the Hearing Room.

For people who qualify as to age, citizenship, or residence *after* the last session for the admission of elections prior to this election, we will be holding a limited registration session on Monday March 25th from 10:00 am until noon. We will be holding this registration session in person at Town Hall in the Hearing Room.

When registering to vote for the first time you must have a valid photo ID that shows name and address. If your ID does not show your current address (i.e. you recently moved here from a different town or state) please also bring a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or government document that shows your name and address.
